

## 63<sup>rd</sup> international victory of the year for Julien Epailard at the Jumping de Saint-Lô



With four show jumping classes and an evening auction of sport horses, the opening day of the Jumping International de Saint-Lô was packed. The public present was able to enjoy a beautiful event at the end of the afternoon, qualifying for Sunday's Grand Prix: the Prix France Étalons at 1m50 - Ranking of the CSI 4\*.

**Julien Epailard**, the leading French rider in the world ranking, won the event with Caracole de la Roque. With a time of 61.27 seconds, it was his 63<sup>rd</sup> international victory of the year. His French teammate, **Gégory Cottard** with Bibici, took second place in 62.86 seconds. **Olivier Perreau** (FRA) riding GL Events Dolce Deceuninck with a time of 63.41 seconds, finished third in the class.

In the 1m40 Prix Agrial of the CSI4\*, **Mathieu Billot** (FRA) riding Défi de Boisy, was the winner ahead of **Reynald Angot** (FRA) and Completely Z. Irish rider **Jessica Burke** completed the podium with Express Trend.

### A bonus for breeders in the CSI 4\*

The GFE (Groupe France Élevage) and the Jumping International of Saint-Lô have joined forces to launch an innovative challenge to reward breeders. The breeders of the 3 best French-born horses ranked in each of the 5 ranking classes of the competition will be rewarded with premiums.

### Ludovic Gaudin, successful in the CSI 2\*

The day started with the Prix Butet at 1m30 in the CSI 2\*. **Laurent Goffinet** (FRA) and Dolcevita de Lacke won ahead of **Edward Levy** (FRA)/Figg Blac and **Ludovic Gaudin** (FRA)/Gicarla.

At the end of the morning, **Ludovic Gaudin** won the Prix Sorapel at 1m40 in the CSI 2\* with Uline Platière. The rider had already won this same event last year with another horse. **Toscane Carloni Richard** (FRA) and Ambre d'Ermisserie took the second place while **Thierry Dupont** (FRA) achieved a great performance by placing his two horses in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> places: Ciel de Sirius and Adéquat des Coteaux.
