

And that's two for Julien Epailard!



Three classes were on the programme this Friday 21 October at the Jumping International de Saint-Lô. The competition ended on a high note with a new victory for Julien Epailard and Caracole de la Roque in the Ranking class of the day.

This morning in the 1m35 Prix Nash of the CSI 2*, **Nicolas Layec** (FRA) won with Echo du Galopin against 61 riders. The Norman riders **Reynald Angot**/Brume de Rauracie and **François-Xavier Boudant**/Egoki took the 2nd and 3rd places.

The Prix Groupama, a 1m40 speed CSI4* was won by **Axel Van Colen** (FRA) and Veyron with a time of 53.90 seconds. The rider also placed his second horse, Europe d'Authuit, in 8th position. **Youri Trotereau** (FRA) with Danae de Vains in 55.98 seconds and **Matis Jones** (FRA) on Joie de Vivre Ter Eycken in 56.75 seconds completed the top three.

The big class of the day was run with a jump-off. It was the Prix Ville de Saint-Lô et Saint-Lô Agglo, a ranking at 1m50, second qualifier for the Grand Prix of the 4*. Of the 53 starters in the initial round, 8 managed to complete the course proposed by Grégory Bodo without penalties, and thus entered the second round. Starting last, **Julien Epailard** (FRA) with Caracole de la Roque, used all his experience to complete the round with the fastest time: 34.56 seconds. He thus takes two victories in two days in the competition's ranking classes. The French Pro Elite champions **Penelope Leprévost** and Texas, with a time of 35.38 seconds, took second place, while **Patrick Guimbal** (FRA) with Bagatelle de Granlieu took third place in 37.17 seconds.

NASH auctions

Nash Auction's first evening of auctions, held yesterday, recorded total sales of €440,500 with an average of €18,000. Twenty-five horses were sold, which represents 70% of the horses presented. The top price was €41,000 for Joye de l'Isle.
