For the 26th edition of the Jumping International de Saint-Lô, Saint-Lô Cheval Organisation invites you to the Pôle Hippique de Saint-Lô from Thursday 26 to Sunday 29 October.

The programme includes 15 classes at 4*, 2* and 1* levels, sure to delight equestrian sports fans and all horse enthusiasts. Five of these classes will enable riders to score points towards the Longines Ranking.

A total of €269,300 will be up in prize money for the riders, including the Grand Prix of the CSI 4* at 100,000 €.

In previous years, **some of the best international riders have taken part in the jumping event:** world No. 1 Henrick Von Eckermann, Olympic champions Steve Guerdat and Scott Brash, Marlon Modolo Zanotelli, Bertram and Harry Allen, Philipp Weishaupt, Pieter Devos, Denis Lynch, Koen Vereeck... But also French riders Julien Epailard, Simon Delestre, Kevin Staut, Pénélope Leprevost, Marc Dilasser, Gregory Cottard, Olivier Perreau, Edward Levy, Julien Anquetin, Roger-Yves Bost...

Jumping, but also sales

The NASH Auction agency will be organising 3 evenings of Elite sport horse auctions on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, and a foal fair will be held outdoors on Saturday morning (Normandie 2014 arena). These sales events will be an opportunity for interested parties to acquire the rare pearl of tomorrow!

And a charity initiative

For more than 10 years, Saint-Lô Cheval Organisation and Jumping International de Saint-Lô have been working together on the **Poulains du Coeur** operation, which mobilises the horse world in a charity initiative to benefit various associations.

Thanks to the support and generosity of breeders, around fifteen covers are auctioned off each year during a major event. The year **2022 was an historic one, with a record €50,000 raised** for a charity that helps people with cancer.

This year, the Jumping international de Saint-Lô will once again be hosting the event, with all proceeds going to the equithérapie centre at the La Musse hospital, which provides therapeutic treatment for patients in addition to medical care.

- 8 covers will be offered for sale online at www.nash.auction during the competition. The auction will close on Saturday evening.
- 8 covers will be offered for physical sale on Sunday at around 2.30pm, before the Grand Prix of the CSI 4*.
