
One month from now, the Saint-Lô 4 International Jumping returns for its 27th edition at the Pôle Hippique de Saint-Lô. Last year's champions, Belgian rider Rik Hemeryck and Inouï du Seigneur, wrote their names into the event's history. From October 23 to 26, 2025, the venue will once again welcome some of the world's top riders for four thrilling days of elite competition.



"For more than 25 years, we have been hosting our international show each autumn at the Pôle Hippique de Saint-Lô. Today, it has become one of the biggest equestrian events in Normandy, the first indoor of the season, and a must-attend rendezvous for the world's top riders ahead of Equita Lyon," says Jean-Claude Heurtaux, organizer and president of Saint-Lô Cheval Organisation.

Each year, the event attracts an outstanding line-up of international riders, featuring some of the sport's biggest names: Henrik von Eckermann, Olympic champions Steve Guerdat and Scott Brash, Marlon Modolo Zanotelli, Bertram and Harry Allen, Philipp Weishaupt, Pieter Devos, Denis Lynch, Wilm Vermeir... Alongside them, the French elite will also be competing, including Julien Epaillard, Kevin Staut, Pénélope Leprevost, Jeanne Sadran, Grégory Cottard, Olivier Perreau, Edward Levy, Julien Anquetin, and Roger-Yves Bost.

Jumping

Four days of competition will feature classes across three levels—CSI 4, CSI 2 and CSI 1*—including FEI Ranking classes that count toward the world rankings.

Grégory Bodo, course designer at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games in Versailles and at many of the world's most prestigious shows, will once again serve as the course designer for the Saint-Lô 4 International Jumping.
